- A COLLABORATIVE ADVISORY COUNCIL AT EACH COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP (CSP) SITE
- REPRESENTATIVES FROM RESIDENTS, INSTITUTIONAL PARTNERS, AND COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS WHO MEET MONTHLY
- THE CSAC WILL IDENTIFY AND ADDRESS THE FUNDAMENTAL NEEDS AND SAFETY ISSUES WITHIN THEIR COMMUNITY
- ADDRESS EACH ISSUE IN SHARED PARTNERSHIP TO OBTAIN COLLECTIVE EFFICACY AND MEET MEASURABLE OUTCOMES AS DOCUMENTED WITHIN EACH SITES UNIQUE STRATEGIC SAFETY PLAN (SSP)

- Obtains SSP updates and communicates with CSP

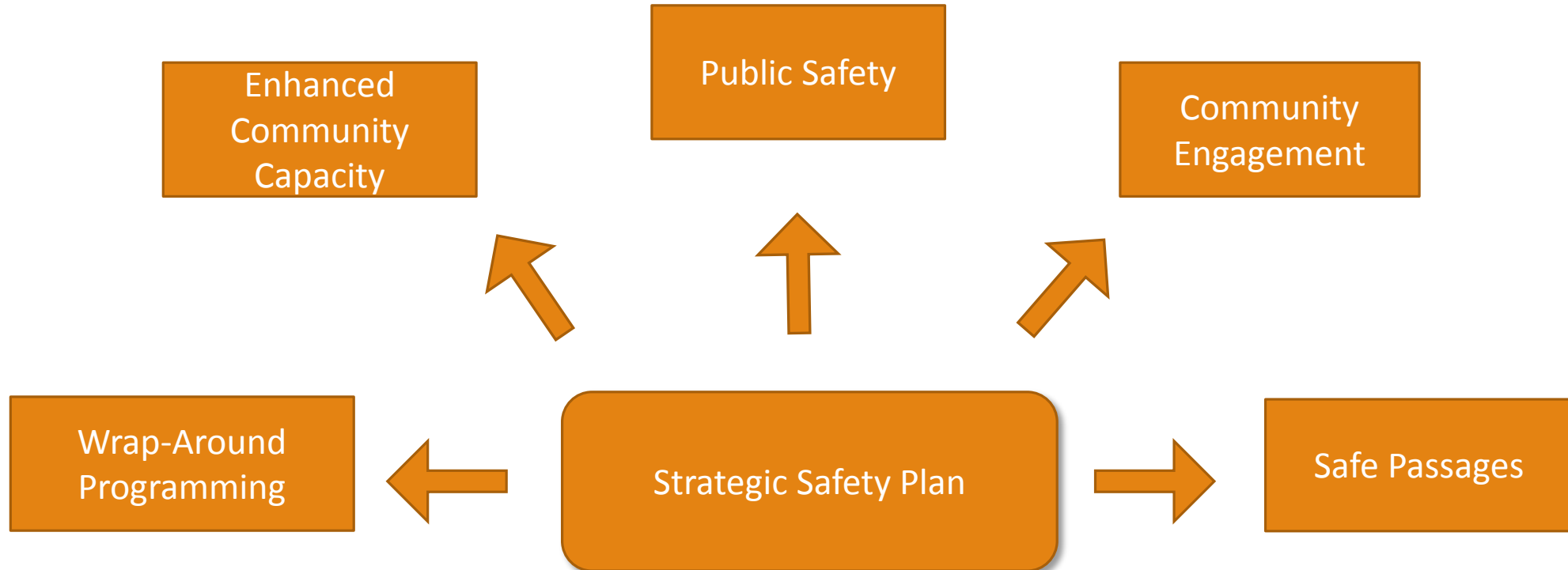
Membership Responsibilities
